



RULES

Violating any of the below listed rules could lead to a camper or leader being sent home without refund:

- 1. There is no food allowed in the cabins only water.**
2. There is no Internet access for campers.
- 3. No Smoking or alcohol on campgrounds. Smoking is only permitted by the front gate parking lot.**
4. No one should bring valuables or jewelry to Lake Frances. The camp is not responsible for lost, broken, or stolen items. All money should be safeguarded, use the camp bank.
5. No pets are permitted to visit the camp due to camper safety issues.
6. Everyone is asked to help in conserving water by not taking showers longer than five minutes, and conserve energy by turning off lights.
7. Lake Frances retains the right to search any bags or personal items brought onto camp property.
10. Parents are encouraged to review all camp rules with their son/daughter before check-in.
11. Be courteous and respectful to the staff at all times.
12. No tobacco products, alcohol, illicit drugs, or weapons allowed.
13. No ignition items (matches, lighters) or fireworks are permitted.
14. Profanity and rude behavior are not acceptable.
15. Violence, demeaning comments, teasing, hazing, put-downs, and making fun of others is not acceptable. Our camp is a positive environment.
16. No horseplay is permitted.
17. No fraternizing (intimate) is permitted.
19. Boys may not enter girls' sleeping areas or visa versa. No exceptions!
23. Please maintain quiet hours after 10:00pm while in the cabins

24. Campers are required to keep their camp rooms clean, orderly and free of damage. Beds must be made-up daily.

25. Camp cabins doors are to remain shut at all times.

26. Please show respect for all camp property. You will be billed for any damages to camp facilities.

27. Please show respect for the personal property of others. Do not touch the personal property of others without permission.

30. Mattresses must stay on bunks.

32. Shoes must be worn at all times, except when taking a shower, in the gym, on the lake, or sleeping.

34. No littering. You are responsible for your own trash.

35. Do not feed the area wildlife.

36. Everyone must wear life vests while participating in any water sports on the lake.

37. You may not use the ropes course or swim in the lake unless there is an authorized staff member on duty (i.e. lifeguard)

38. Please do not touch fire extinguishers or alarms unless there is an emergency.

39. Please stay on all marked trails and roads while at the camp. Wandering into the wooded or lake areas are not permitted.

40. Please do not go under the cabins.

41. No campers are allowed on the hiking trails without adult supervision.
